Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is conducted by the Ocean County NJ USBC Bowling Association and all USCBC rules will apply. This tournament committee reserves all rights and is the final authority to accept or reject any entries. This committee will render spot decisions when required.
2. Eligibility- Entry is open to ALL Ocean County NJ USBC certified bowlers:
 - a. with 21 games in the 2021-23 season (includes summer leagues)
 - b. 21 games in this current (2021-2022) season (as of 11/11/2022)
 - c. Any Ocean County resident
3. All bowlers must present a current Ocean County NJ USBC membership card or Temporary membership stub.
4. Dress Code – All participants must wear dress slacks, full length casual trousers, skirts, or jeans with a bowling shirt, mock collar or shirt with butterfly collar. No T shirts, hats, shorts, warm up pants, UBA/ Federation jerseys or sweat pants allowed. The tournament committee reserves the right to determine proper attire.
5. Lane Assignment: Lanes will be pre-assigned by the tournament director. Depending on the number of entries, the tournament director reserves the right to schedule any number of bowlers to a pair of lanes.
6. Format:
 - 5 game qualifier across lanes moving to a new pair each game. Field is cut down to 15 bowlers for match play finals held Sunday November 13, 2022
 - The 2021 Masters Champion will be seeded into the finals in 8th place; if they so desire, they may try to improve their placement by submitting a paid entry into Saturday's qualifying round.
 - Sunday's match play format will consist of 3-game head to head matches (total series wins match), with single elimination
 - Competition will begin promptly at 11:00 AM Sunday November 13, 2022. Late bowlers will receive zero for any frames missed
7. Entry Forms: All entries must be received by **Friday November 7, 2022**, with the following exceptions (see below) * Payment **MUST** accompany all entries. * NO REFUNDS will be given to paid entries who fail to check in or notify the tournament director prior to the tournament starting date. Only one entry per bowler.
8. Report to lanes 30 minutes prior to squad time for check in. Failure to do so can result in forfeiture of entry.

****The first 120 mailed or filed entries take precedence over all others. Entries can be confirmed with telephone reservations with the tournament director.***

After the closing date applications will be accepted to fill any remaining open spots. The decision to accept these entries will be determined by the tournament director and will be based on balancing lane assignments rather than filling the 120 spots.
