1. This tournament shall be sanctioned through the USBC. Any Junior bowler who is not sanctioned in Ocean County must present a valid 2023-2024 sanction card. High School aged bowlers not currently sanctioned must pay a \$5.00 participation fee.

2. **FEES** - Entry fees are \$50.00 per team of which - \$29.00 is for lineage and \$21.00 goes toward scholarships. **All checks should be made payable to OCEAN LANES.** There will be an additional charge of \$10.00 for entrees received after Sept. 30, 2023.

3. **SCHOLARSHIPS** - \$3000.00 in Scholarships will be guaranteed. 1<sup>st</sup> \$700, 2<sup>nd</sup> 550, 3<sup>rd/4th</sup> \$400( A Bracket ) 5<sup>th</sup> 300, 6<sup>th</sup> 250, 5<sup>th/6th</sup> 200 ( B Bracket) based on 20 teams.

**\*\*The 2 Junior Gold spots were graciously donated by the Romano Family\*\***

4. **FORMAT** - This is a Doubles Handicap Tournament with all teams bowling 4 games across 2 pairs of lanes. The top 4 teams will then compete in bracket finals consisting of 2 bakery games with winners being decided by total pin fall including handicap. In case of a tie for 4<sup>th</sup> place there will be a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off. If there is a tie within the top 4 the higher team game bowled decides the tie breaker. If 20 teams or more an A/B Bracket final will be run.

5. **HANDICAP** - Handicap will be based on 85% of the difference of the team's average and 440.

6. **AVERAGE** - (**HOUSE SHOT**) Bowler's average will be 1) their highest 2022-2023 book average with a minimum of 21 games. If there is no 2022-2023 book average, bowlers will 2) use their 2023 summer average of 21 or more games. If bowler has neither of above, the bowler will 3) use 2021-2022 winter average of 21 or more games. If no average, bowler will 4) enter with an average of 210.

7. **Junior Gold** - This Tournament will also be awarding 2 Junior Gold Spots, 1 Boy spot and 1 Girl spot will be awarded for the Junior Gold Event in July 2024. All bowlers wishing to compete for a Junior Gold Spot must be a current Junior Gold member prior to throwing a ball in this event. The spots will be awarded for the highest 4 game total(Qualifying) of Junior Gold Members, 1 for the boys and 1 for the girls. In the event of a tie for either of the Junior Gold Spots, a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame Roll-off will determine the winner. If the highest Junior Gold bowler already has a spot for the 2023 Junior Gold event, it will go to the next eligible bowler in the same division(Boy/Girl).

8. **TIME** - This tournament will start at 12:30pm. Check in is at 12:00pm. Any bowler who arrives after the start of the tournament will receive zero pin fall for any missed frames. Late bowlers will receive no practice.

9. **DRESS CODE** - **ALL BOWLERS ARE TO BE PROPERLY ATTIRED.** Bowlers are permitted to wear Jeans, skorts, or shorts, (skorts/shorts must be at least finger tip length) **HOWEVER, NO BASKETBALL SHORTS.** No see-through blouses, baggy pants, or pants below the waist will be permitted. No vulgarisms on clothing will be permitted. No hats or caps may be worn. No electronic devices will be permitted in the bowling area during tournament play. **The tournament director shall decide proper attire.**

10. **No Altering of a Ball Surface, once the lanes are put on for tournament play.**

Any rules not specifically addressed by the tournament rules will be in accordance with USBC rules. If you are not sure, **ASK!**

11. Final 4/8 teams will receive 5 minutes of practice at the start of the final 4/8 round.
